CHARLOTTE STONE CRABS (34-35) vs. BRADENTON MARAUDERS (43-23)

BRADENTON SURVIVES WILD SEVENTH: The Stone Crabs mounted a late inning charge that erased an substantial early deficit, but the Bradenton Marauders squeaked out a 10-9 victory last night in the home finale at Charlotte Sports Park.

Trailing 9-2 in the seventh, a two-out rally in the seventh inning turned into a game changer by the time the Stone Crabs were done hitting. Bradenton relievers Tyler Waldron and Zach Foster were worked over for seven runs as Charlotte tied the game 9-9.

Deivis Mavarez took the loss after allowing a ninth inning run to the Marauders. Cole White's bleeder down the right field line brought home pinch-runner David Rubinstein with the eventual game-winning run. Diego Moreno worked the ninth for his fifth save.

BE LIKE MIKE: First baseman Mike Sheridan continued his recent tear to close the season. He has driven in seven runs in his last two games, including four more on Saturday. That gives Sheridan a career-high 71 RBI's on the year, which is also good for a franchise single-season record. His 38 doubles are a career best and second most in the FSL and yet another record for a Stone Crabs hitter in a single-season.

TYPICAL BORTY STUFF: Second baseman Tyler Bortnick finished 2-for-4 with two more runs scored last night. He swiped his FSL leading 43rd base of the year while bumping his league best on-base percentage up to .427 for the season. Bortnick's 95 runs scored set a franchise record and rank second only to Bradenton's Robbie Grossman (127). Bortnick also paces the league in a rather painful stat, most times hit by pitch (25).

RT: @RICCIO_TORREZ: Third baseman Riccio Torrez connected for his first home run of the year for the Stone Crabs in the completion of Thursday's suspended game. He added a pair of RBI's on Saturday as well and has now drive in six runs in his seven games with Charlotte. The 21-year-old Torrez was taken in the 4th Round of this past June Draft out of Arizona State.

BRADENTON CLINCHES SECOND HALF: The Bradenton Marauders clinched the FSL South second-half title Tuesday with a 6-3 win over the Palm Beach Cardinals. The Marauders have turned in the best record of any team in the FSL in the second half, entering Saturday with a very impressive 42-23 mark in earning their second playoff berth in as many seasons.

END OF SEASON ALL-STAR DUO: The FSL announced the 2011 End of Season All-Stars on Monday. The list is comprised of the top players from both divisions and features two Charlotte Stone Crabs players. Second baseman Tyler Bortnick and shortstop Hak-Ju Lee earned the honor for their fine overall play this season. Both men were also named to the FSL Mid-Season All-Star team earlier this season

MAKING HIS MARK: Catcher Mark Thomas belted his 13th home run of the season in Sunday's win over Fort Myers. That longball sent Thomas past Henry Wrigley's year old mark for most homers by a Charlotte player in a single season. His 13 home runs and 64 RBI's lead the club and all catchers in the FSL, as does his .483 caught stealing percentage behind the plate.

THE NEED FOR SPEED: The Stone Crabs had two more stolen bases against the Marauders on Saturday. That gives Charlotte a league-leading 171 steals on the year. Second baseman Tyler Bortnick is leading the FSL with his club record 43 stolen bases.
